Science Week

Our Science Week Theme has been: **Curiosity – What's Your Question?**

Children were set the task of doing their own investigations and have shared what they have discovered about the things they are curious about.

Year 2 became minibeast explorers! We counted and recorded the number of minibeasts found in different microhabitats using tally charts to help us organise and interpret our data.



We also enjoyed identifying creatures living in our pond. We made some exciting discoveries including; froglets, tadpoles, water boatmen, water lice, bloodworms, water snails, leeches and whirligig beetles. A fantastic hands-on way to develop our science and maths skills outdoors!

Today, we were visited by 'Mad Science' for a special assembly called 'Mission to Mars'. This fun and interactive assembly explored how a rocket can safely reach Mars.

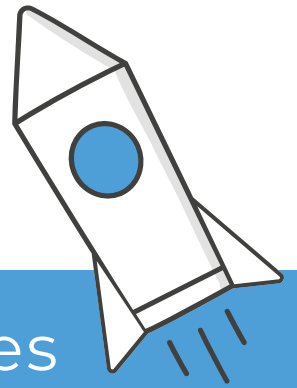
